



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Can I just register at the event?

No! We will not take walk-ons on the day of the event. Most of our events are advertised 3 months in advance so if you missed it, wait until the next event. Our events take time to plan and we need to know who we are taking into battle. Game play is much better if it is well organized and that starts with the players.

How do I register for Militia?

Select RUSFOR (Blue Force) when you click on the registration button. Militia is a faction of Russian Forces.

How do I get into the chat groups?

We currently use FB for chats. You must have a profile and you must be a registered player for the faction you are requesting access to. We vet the profile against the registration. This is a simple forum (chat) to ask questions and coordinate organization of the faction. It is not a strategy channel. Operation Orders will be given by the CO on the day of the event and FRAG Orders will follow throughout the event.

Can I wear my super awesome Black Multi-cam?

No. Unless you are bringing a squad of 8 or more and it is cleared by Viking Airsoft LLC.

Can I use my super awesome Mandalorian Blaster?

No. We prefer weapon systems from this galaxy. If you have a question about whether your replica fits the role, please ask Viking Airsoft LLC or a cadre member.

What BBs should I bring?

Please don't. We supply the BB's. Most of our venues require bio-BB's. We also use a controlled supply chain (like the military). We will issue you an initial supply, and then you will be re-supplied during the event. This is a big part of game play. We use .25 weighted BBs and we have .40 for DMR's and Snipers. There may be some mix of .30 available. We try and use HPA and Elite Force for our BB supply.

Can I use my standard, battle rattle, high-capacity magazine?

No. Mid capacity or low (real) capacity mags only. Unless you running an LMG or MMG.

Do I have to read the REGS (rules)?

Yes! Don't shortcut. Read, and be familiar with the rules. Our rules are different from other vendors. We are similar to MSW...but also different. We will do a safety briefing and your commander will do an OP Order (Operational Briefing) on game day. You have to know all the rest...like how to apply a TQ...or how a medic applies an IV...or how to die in a loud grotesque military manner.
